

Directions to Timber Point Country Club

From New York City and Nassau County

Take Long Island Expressway east to exit 53, Sagtikos Parkway south. At end of Sagtikos Parkway, bear left onto Southern Parkway east, which becomes Hecksher Parkway.

OR:

Take Belt Parkway east or Cross Island Parkway south to Southern Parkway east, which becomes Hecksher Parkway.

THEN:

Take exit 45 E, Route 27A-Montauk Highway east. At first light, turn right onto Great River Road, and continue straight through gates into Timber Point Country Club.

From Eastern Long Island:

Take Long Island Expressway west to exit 58, Nichols Road south. At 454 make left turn onto Veterans Memorial Highway, make right turn onto Connetquot Avenue, which becomes Great River Road at 27A.

OR:

Go west on Route 27A-Montauk Highway. At first light past Bayard Cutting Arboretum, turn left onto Great River Road.

THEN:

Continue on Great River Road past intersection with River Road, through gates into Timber Point Country Club.
